Join us for a fascinating talk by Dr. Myles McGregor-Lowndes, Director of The Australian Centre for Philanthropy and Nonprofit Studies, who has been recognized for providing education and support in legal, financial and administrative matters to nonprofit organizations. Professor McGregor-Lowndes is currently working with the Australian Productivity Commission during its examination of the role of the voluntary sector in the Australian economy.

Professor McGregor-Lowndes will provide an overview of current and emerging practice and thinking in the regulation of the voluntary sector in Australia, including the move to a Standard Chart of Accounts. The Standard Chart of Accounts provides a common approach to the capture of accounting information by community organizations for use by nonprofits, government agencies and other interested parties. It is a tool designed primarily for small to medium nonprofits which typically do not have an accounting department or a sophisticated accounting system.
